Morris Health Services is owned and operated by St. Francis Health Services (SFHS) located in West Central Minnesota in the city of Morris. Morris Health Services includes West Wind Village, an 82 bed skilled nursing facility and Skyview Court and Skyview Plaza, 72 units of housing with services. Rural Rehabilitation Services is therapy clinic located in Skyview Plaza that provides physical, occupational and speech therapy to the community. Morris Health Services also encompasses Caring Suites, a 6 unit dementia care home located in Elbow Lake, MN and Walnut Court, 8 units of independent living located in Hancock, MN. Morris Health Services provides a resident centered, hospitality care model which enhances each individual's life with professional and caring services to help each resident achieve his or her highest potential.

In an average year, Morris Health Services cares for approximately **150** residents and tenants; approximately 99% are from Morris and the surrounding communities.
